- CC Open every day
- **More church support to CC, (volunteers and customers)**
- CC known as a community resource – come here first for your needs – can recycle your goods, etc.
- Increase funding to other agencies with the CC profits
- The community needs to know that the CC is more than a shop. There's fellowship, friendship, engage the community, more.
- **Add signage and publicity to communicate this hidden treasure and for drawing business in.**
- CC should have say over what organizations receive donations
- Larger space for the CC needs – would like to expand
- Continue to attract more volunteers from outside the church
- New Kitchen for HCC, (Pine Street meal prep requires better facilities)
- Spiffy up whole building
- Siding next to CC door is falling off and whole church needs a paint job
- Improve the landscaping around the church
- The spotlight area needs improvement
- A Capital Improvement Campaign would be good. There hasn't been one in many years.
- CC should be a place for information as to where people can go for help
- HCC should provide women's programs on other nights than Wednesdays. Working women need more options.
- Need a woman's group, like the Men's group
- Need more secular programs, (like the Medical Ethics program we had years ago)
- More intergenerational programs and ministries and community service projects
- Youth representation on boards and committees
- Partner shut-ins with someone in our church for emergencies
- **Get CC updated technologically, (build web-site, etc.)**
